During the Procedure

1 The Process

After sanitizing the area, your provider uses a pen-like cryoprobe to rapidly freeze and destroy the unwanted tissue.

* Freezing time: 3–20 seconds — blink and you'll miss it (unless you're blinking from the cold).

what You Will Feel

Expect an **intense icy sting**, like winter slapped your skin.

It calms down to a milder pain within minutes, so don't worry — the **Arctic blast moment is brief.**

Treatment Duration

Each spot takes just **3–20 seconds**. Fast, effective, and a little frosty.

* After Care

What Your Skin Will Look Like

- Swelling for 1–2 hours is common.
- Within 24–48 hours, the area turns red, then darkens, then forms a scab.
- Scab heals in 1–3 weeks.
 - Warts or stubborn spots may need several rounds. (They're just being dramatic.)

✓ Things to Do

* Cold compresses: 5 minutes on, 10 minutes off — repeat several times per hour to calm your skin.

h Apply healing ointments at night:

- Nanosilver both from Crystal Skin Use a **thin layer only** — we're soothing, not smothering.
- **Showering & swimming** are totally fine your skin won't melt.
- **Keep your skincare routine**, but treat the area gently:

Band-Aid bonus:

Cover the area with a dry Band-Aid to protect it from damage, irritation, or sunburn. If it blisters, still cover it — no popping zone!

○ Things to Avoid

🛕 DO. NOT. PICK. THE. SCAB.

We cannot stress this enough.

Picking = scarring = regret.

Let it fall off naturally like a responsible adult skin cell.
